**If You Could Rule The World**

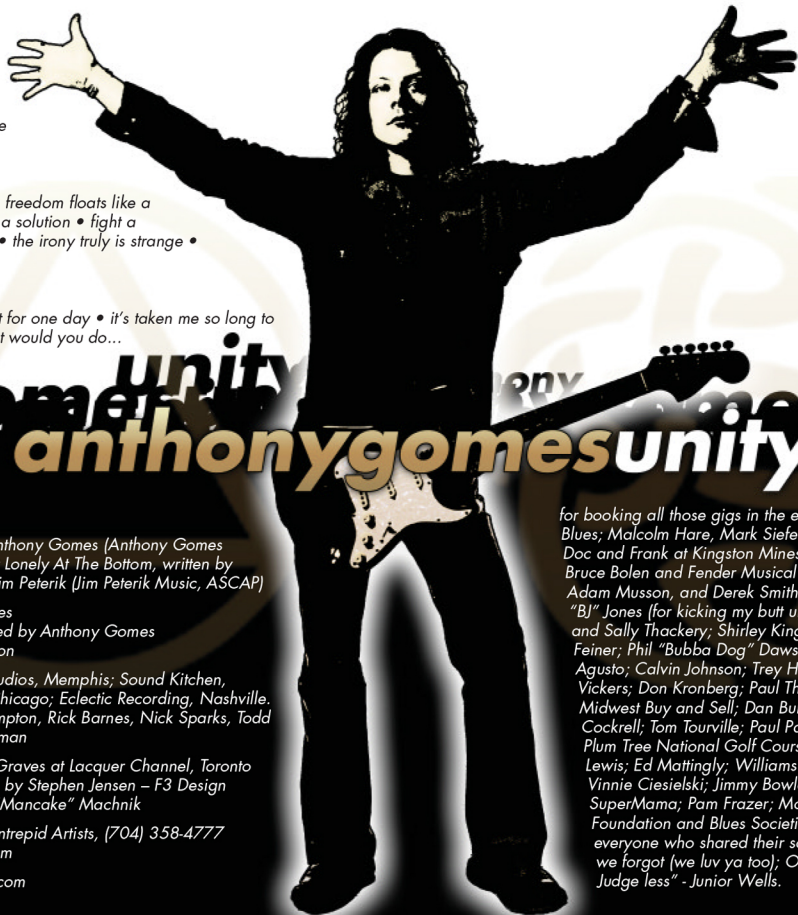
